

Frontline NHS staff are fighting a daily battle in extremely difficult conditions to take care of us. Following a crowdfunding campaign online to purchase the necessary materials, Damien raised £2,000 in under 24 hours. His efforts to raise funds attracted the attention of Dodd Group and O'Neill & Brennan with both companies stepping in to purchase additional 3D Printers for him to work with. His man-cave has now become the home to a potentially life-saving cottage industry and typifies the spirit of innovation in the face of adversity.
